
Raised Surface Map of the Land of Israel Three Cities Markers and Collage Pieces



Free Standing Markers





Markers Inserted Into Hole in Map



Make markers by shaping sculptey, clay or paper mache; OR cut from wood wood. Attach markers to a nail, heavy pin or wood. Attach the marker to a base, if you wish the markers to be free standing. Paint.

NOTE: Gold paint sometimes ages and turns brown, so yellow can be used for the Cross and Star Comet. The Star Coment tail shoots from heaven so it must point upwards.

Use small box or basket to store the symbols/markers near the Raised Surface Map.

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Optional: Flame or Dove

Use either a red flame OR a white dove as the symbol/marker for Nazareth to represent the Holy Spirit.

Controls

If you use a Dove, consistently use it for the collage pieces and for the controls the child uses as a guide. (see example below)

If you use a Flame, consistently use it for the collage pieces for the the controls the child uses as a guide. (see example below)

Collage Pieces (Construction or art paper)

Print Flames on RED paper and cut Print Doves on WHITE paper and cut Print Star Comet and Crosses on YELLOW paper and cut

Store in divided container or tray near the paper maps

Additional Materials Pasting Set Colored pencils or crayons

OLDER CHILDREN

For an older Level 1 child, and for Level II and III children, markers for all three cities with the names of the cities are used. They are also free standing.
